Overview

Key Responsibilities

Aquaculture / Fish Farming

- **Fish Care**: Assist in feeding, monitoring, and maintaining the health of fish stocks, ensuring optimal water quality and environmental conditions.
- Equipment operation: Safely operate fish farm machinery (eg fish graders, pumps) after appropriate training.
- **Facility Maintenance**: Participate in the cleaning and upkeep of fish tanks, raceways, and related equipment to maintain high standards of hygiene and operational efficiency.
- **Record Keeping**: Accurately record data related to fish growth, health and environmental parameters (oxygen, water quality).
- **Preparation of orders**: Help to prepare fish for live restocking deliveries and for table customers, adhering to established protocols.

Visitor Experience Support

• **Customer Engagement**: Provide a warm welcome to visitors, assisting with family fishing activities and fishing ticket sales.



General Duties

- **Team Collaboration:** Work closely with colleagues including the Fish Farm General Manager to ensure seamless operations across the business, supporting both aquaculture and visitor services.
- Site maintenance: Participate in general maintenance tasks, including landscaping, cleaning, and basic repairs, to ensure the business remains welcoming and functional.
- **Health and Safety Compliance**: Adhere to all health and safety regulations, reporting any hazards or incidents promptly to management.
